1. Cl. 20-6 and 20-19, 25 Any size. Limited to Cupids, Cherubs, and Angels. Jamie Wolfe of Space Center Button Club. \$10-7-3

2. Cl. 1-0 through 15-5, 15 Any size. Best overall assortment of materials and techniques. No limit on pictorials. Kathy Hurst. \$10-6-4.
3. Cl. 17-0 through 20-24, 15 Any size. Best assortment of pictorials specialized to food or food preparation, Assorted materials. Kathy Hurst \$10-6-4.

Division IX

4. Cl 1-1, 25 Any size. Celluloid body types assorted. Label the body types with subclass. (For example 1-1.1 Hollow Body) Points deducted for incorrect labels, but no disqualification for mistakes in labeling. Bluebonnet Button Club. \$10-6-4.
